The project

WallSpace and Community Clean joined forces with Hertfordshire Highways, Amey LaFarge, Mouchel and Broxbourne Borough Council to fully refurbish a central subway complex. They were looking for an innovative system to transform the look of the subways, whilst promoting areas nearby.

The designs for each tunnel were based on creating a light, bright and informative space, transforming the once dark and imposing surfaces.

The WallSpace system transforms surfaces using a digitally printed vinyl that shrink wraps to the contours of the substrate. The speed of application meant that each tunnel could be completed quickly and efficiently, keeping any disruption to an absolute minimum.

The project also involved general refurbishment works to complete the full transformation. This included: deep cleaning, replacement benches, rendering, anti-graffiti coatings and painting works.

The benefits

Value for money and highly visual, a first class finish can be achieved at a fraction of the cost of traditional repair or renovation methods. If the finish is vandalised in any way, individual panels can be removed and replaced, very easily.
